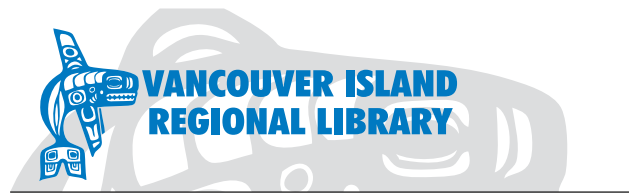

How to get your free Library card

If you live, work, go to school, or own property in the region served by Vancouver Island Regional Library, you qualify for a free Library card. Please bring identification with your name and address to your nearest Vancouver Island Regional Library branch, or complete an online application form at www.virl.bc.ca.

You must show your Library card every time you borrow materials. You will receive a four-digit PIN (Personal Identification Number) to use on our website so you can check your records, request or renew items, or access other Library services.

Children under 13 years of age can get their own Library card. A parent or guardian must sign the application form and take responsibility for materials borrowed and/or fines owing.

Your Library card entitles you to borrow or request materials from any of our 38 branches and our virtual branch (www.virl.bc.ca). Your Library card also allows you to use other public libraries in British Columbia.

What you can do with your Library card

Your Library card allows you to:

- Borrow books, talking books, movies, magazines, music, and more.
- Request items.
- Access the Internet.
- Use word processing, spreadsheet, presentation, photo editing softwares and more.
- Search databases for information.

If you live in a remote location within the region served by Vancouver Island Regional Library, you can have your Library items mailed to you – just register as a *Books by Mail* customer.

How long you can borrow items

- Most items: 21 days
- High-demand items: 7 and 14 days
- Some reference items: 3 days

The Library reserves the right to limit the number of items borrowed at one time on a specific subject.

Renewals

You may renew materials twice – online, by phone, or in person. If someone else has requested an item, you will not be able to renew.



Requests

You can request items from any Vancouver Island Regional Library branch by visiting our website www.virl.bc.ca, or you can talk to a staff member. For your convenience, items will be shipped to the Library branch you choose for pick up. We will email or phone you when your items are ready to be picked up. Items can be returned at any VIRL branch.

Cardholder's responsibilities

- Check out all Library materials before removal from the building.
- Return materials in good condition on or before the due date.
- Inform us if you have lost your Library card or Library item(s), and/or change your address or phone number.
- Inform the Library as soon as possible if there are errors in your account.
- Pay fines assessed for late, lost or damaged materials; you can pay in person or online.

Respect for others

We hope you enjoy the Library. During your visit, please be respectful of others.

- For their protection, children must not be left unattended.
- Pets are not allowed on the premises, except trained assistance animals.
- Limit the use of cell phones.
- VIRL does not accept responsibility for personal items lost or stolen on its premises.

Privacy

In accordance with BC's *Freedom of Information/Protection of Privacy Act*, your personal information is kept confidential, unless you give written consent for release or records are requested via subpoena or court order. More information is available online or from staff.

Fees and fines

You can borrow Library materials free of charge; however, we will charge you a fine if the items are not returned by the required due date, as follows:

	Adult Materials	Children's Materials
Books	\$ 0.30/day	\$ 0.10/day
Videos/DVDs	\$ 0.30/day	\$ 0.10/day
CDs	\$ 0.30/day	\$ 0.10/day
Express Reads Interlibrary Loans Reference Items	\$1.50/day	\$ 0.50/day
Literacy Kits	\$1.50/day	\$1.50/day

We will send you a courtesy email reminder when your items are overdue. Maximum overdue fine is \$10 per item; you will be blocked from further borrowing until fines are paid.

Other fees

- Lost items – full replacement cost of the item plus a processing fee.
- Lost cards – \$2 for replacing an adult card; \$1 for a children's card. Notify your branch immediately if you have lost your card; otherwise, you will be responsible for its use.

Fees are subject to change without prior notice.
