This recognition is given to employers who employ people with developmental disabilities.

Vancouver Island Regional Library established a partnership with Vancouver Island Vocational & Rehabilitation Services in 2011 to allow adult pages to serve in our Courtney, Nanaimo Harbourfront, Parksville, Port Alberni and Sidney branches, and at our Administration and Support Services locations in Nanaimo. The three Nanaimo locations being recognized are the Poplar Street Administration location, the Boban Drive Support Services location, and the down town Nanaimo Harbourfront Branch.
