We serve over 430,000 people on Vancouver Island, Haida Gwaii and the Central Coast (Bella Coola) through 39 branch libraries, our eLibrary and a books by mail service. Administrative offices are located in Nanaimo.

Vancouver Island Regional Library opened its doors in 1936 as the Vancouver Island Union Library; it was the second regional library in North America.



From story-telling to adult education and digital literacy training: your local library is an invaluable resource to the community. *A typical Storytime will be two stories read aloud.


