



# PRIDE WINDOW STARS

## Getting Started

### Supplies Provided:

- 8 sheets of square or rectangle tissue paper
- Instructions

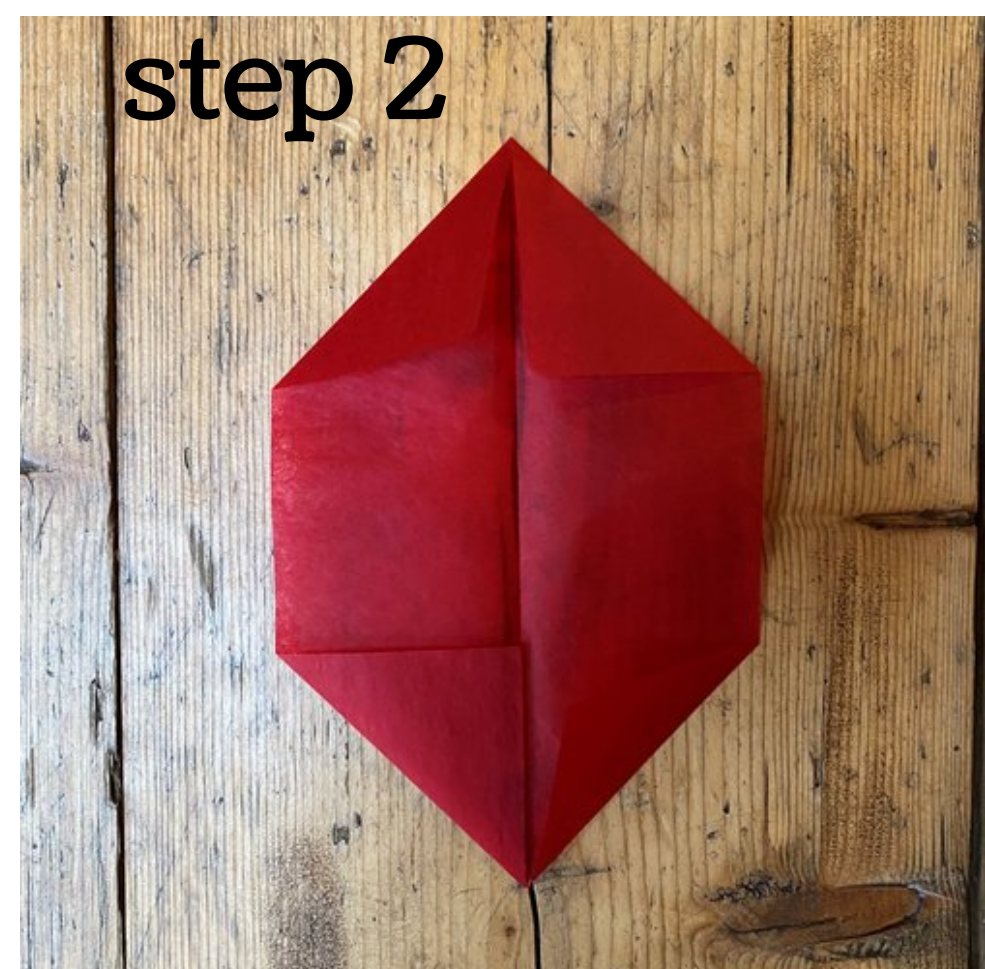
### Supplies Not Included:

- Stick glue



## Steps

1. Lay one piece of your coloured tissue paper on the table in front of you. Fold it in half to make a crease lengthways.
2. Open your tissue out again and fold in the corners to the middle crease. Leave the corners folded in.
3. Then, on just one of the corners, fold the edges over to the middle crease to make a kite shape.
4. You have finished one section of your star! Do the same with all eight of your pieces of paper.







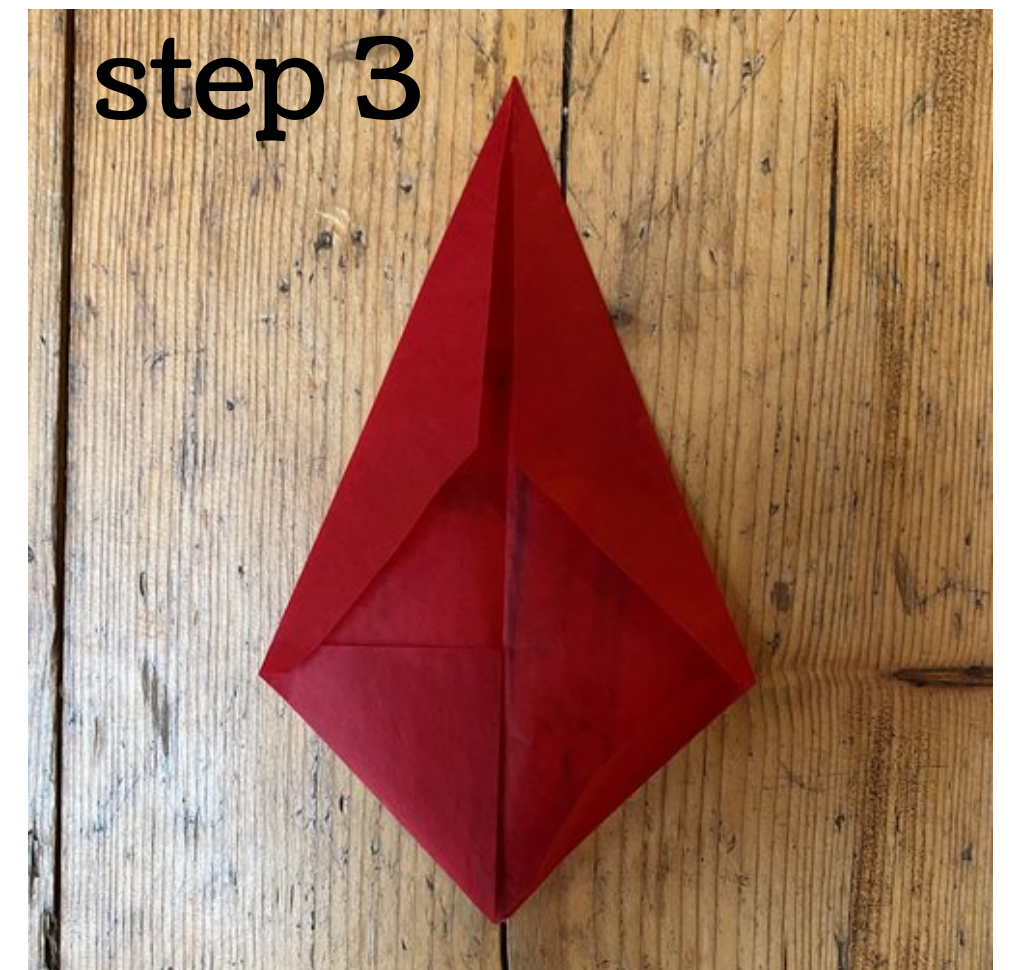
## Steps Continued

5. When all eight pieces are folded, arrange them on a table with the long points at the top and the short points at the bottom.

6. Take two of your star sections. Put some glue carefully onto the short end of one of your sections. Stick another star section carefully on top of it, making sure it sticks to the middle folded line.

7. Put more glue on your second section and attach the next one – making sure, again, that the side of your short end goes along the middle fold of the section it is being glued to.

8. Continue until seven of your pieces are glued together. To attach your final section, lift the first section and slide half of the short end of your last one under it.



**You're all finished! Hang your star in the window so the colours can catch the sun.**
