



Creativity Commons VHS Digitization Waiver

The Creativity Commons branch of the Vancouver Island Regional Library (VIRL) offers VHS video digitization service for all branches in the VIRL service area.

Please read and sign the following to confirm you understand and agree to the requirements and limitations of the service:

1. You must have an active library account.
2. Up to two VHS tapes may be submitted per household for digitization at one time.
3. You must provide a storage device for the digitized file (DVD or USB stick).
4. VHS tapes must not contain copyrighted material (e.g. feature films, television).
5. VHS content must not be sexual in nature.
6. If VHS content is contrary to provincial or federal law, library staff will be obligated to report it.
7. VIRL does not accept responsibility for your VHS or equipment if it is damaged or destroyed while using library equipment.*
8. Please note the digitization process can take up to two weeks.

How it Works

1. Complete the waiver on the flipside of this page, sign it, and put it back in a Ziplock bag with up to two VHS tapes & a storage device for the digitized video (USB stick or blank DVD disc).
2. Drop off the Ziplock bag with the completed waiver, VHS tape(s) and storage device at your nearest branch during library open hours.
3. Digitization will be completed at the Nanaimo Harbourfront branch by Creativity Common staff.
4. Staff will contact you when your VHS tape(s) have been digitized and are ready for pickup or shipment. Please allow 2-4 weeks for processing.
